

TOWN OF GOLDEN

BYLAW NUMBER 1099

Being a Bylaw of the Town of Golden to amend Sign Control Bylaw Number 830, 1991

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Golden deems it desirous to repeal certain provisions of the Sign Control Bylaw to expedite approval of certain types of signs;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Golden, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Section 2 of Sign Control Bylaw Number 830, 1991, is amended by deleting clause f) and replacing it with a new clause f):
 - f) Off-site sign means a sign advertising a business, commodity, service or entertainment which is conducted, sold or offered elsewhere from where the sign is located.
2. Schedule "A" to Sign Control Bylaw Number 830, 1991, is hereby amended by:
 - a) deleting the provisions for off-site signs and replacing them with the provisions attached as Schedule "A" to this bylaw;
 - b) deleting clause c) from the Site requirements for Fascia Signs.
 - c) Relettering the subsequent clause d) as clause c.)
3. "Sign Control Bylaw Number 587, 1982" is hereby repealed.
4. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as: "Sign Control Bylaw Number 830, 1991, Amendment Bylaw No. 1099, 2004".

READ A FIRST TIME THIS THE 3rd DAY OF February, 2004.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE 3rd DAY OF February, 2004.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 3rd DAY OF February, 2004.
